John 3:15 that whoever believes in him may **have eternal life**.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but **have eternal life**.

John 3:36 Whoever believes in the Son **has eternal life**; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

John 4:14 but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him **a spring** of water welling up to **eternal life**.

John 4:36 Already the one who reaps is receiving wages and gathering **fruit for eternal life**, so that sower and reaper may rejoice together.
